In addition, Dr Kissinger was the Director of Armed Forces Baptist Missions, Chairman of the Commission on Military Chaplains for the Fundamental Baptist Fellowship, and presently continues serving as a missionary with *Way of Truth Baptist Missions*, ministries to Africa and India.
